Back to The Basics - No 3: God, The Holy Trinity

God reveals Himself as a Triune God - as God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit, yet as One God.....

1. The Bible is about God – the Triune God.

Creation and Purpose- Genesis 1-3

- God is One Deuteronomy / 1 Cor 8:6
- God is Three (Matt. 28:19); (2 Cor. 13:14)
- The three persons are each fully God Jesus (John 10:30; Philippians 2:5-6; Col 2:9-10; John 20:27-28); The Holy Spirit (Acts 20:28; John 14:26; 1 Cor 2:13; Acts 8:29; Eph 4:30; Acts 5:3,4
- Each of the persons is distinct from the others -
- The three persons are related eternally as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit -
- 2. The Bible is written to **specific audiences at specific times** to reveal who God is, through what God does and says (or has said) to various peoples.

Major Movements in the Biblical Story of God and Humanity

- Creation and Purpose (Romans 11:33; Col 1:15-17)
- Fall/and its Effects (Romans 5:12; 1 Cor 15:21)
- Redemption Process / History (Re-'creation') (Romans 8:29ff; John 6:43ff)
- Restoration and Purpose (Revelation 21:22; 22: 1ff)
- 3. The Bible is progressive! We are learning more about God as more is revealed to us about God by God.

Here are some examples taken from: (Who Is God? Key Moments of Biblical Revelation: By Richard Bauckham - 2020)

- The Revelation of the Divine Presence Gen 28:10-22 (Jacob at "The House of God" / Link Ps 23:4 / Isaiah 7:14 with Matt 1:23 God with us/Emmanuel, with Matthew 28:16-20 Jesus' promise to be with his disciples always.
- The Revelation of the Divine Name Exodus 3:1-6 (God reveals His Name to Moses at the Burning Bush –I will be who I will be! To Lord/Jesus- No other name).
- The Revelation of the Divine Character Exodus 33:18-23 & 34 Moses asks to see God's glory/ Links to Numbers 6:22-27; then to John 1:14, 16-18 then is shown through the rest of Jesus ministry and John's gospel.
- The Revelation of the Trinity All based on Isaiah's hope in God and promises to His people linked within: 1) Mark 1:9-11 The Jesus Baptism (2) Mark 9:2-8 Jesus' Transfiguration (3) Mark 15:37-39. The Centurions observation and confession of Jesus.

Concluding Comments:

- **Seekers** (disciples/evangelism): Honest enquires require the telling of the whole of the bible though in parts.
- *Sceptics*: Don't back down from mystery, the scriptures, or The One and Only Triune God.
- You and the Trinity: Delight yourself in the Trinity, the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
